

Single adult membership fee: £25.00 per year

Household membership fee: £35.00 per year

Junior supplement fee: £10.00 per year

Membership includes regular newsletters and the opportunity to audition and attend social events. Members also enjoy special reduced ticket prices, and receive two free tickets each year. Household Membership is defined as a couple living in the same household including young family members in full-time compulsory education. Should any children in the household join Children's Theatre or Youth Group, then an additional annual supplement of £10.00 per child is payable.

Members shall be elected by the Board of Trustees, and the name and address of any person making application for membership must, for not less than two days before the election, be prominently displayed in a part of the Theatre Centre frequented by the members. No person may be admitted to membership or to any of the privileges of membership without having first been elected in accordance with this Article.

Any payment made with the application will be returned if your membership is rejected by the Board of Trustees.

Extract from the Memorandum of Association of Beckenham Theatre Centre Ltd.

5.1 The income and property of the Charity shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the Objects.

5.3. None of the income or property of the Charity may be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by dividend bonus or otherwise by way of profit to any member of the Charity.

This does not prevent a member who is not also a Trustee receiving;

(A) a benefit from the Charity in the capacity of a beneficiary of the Charity

(B) reasonable and proper remuneration for any goods or services supplied to the Charity.

6. The liability of the members is limited.

7. Every member promises, if the charity is dissolved while he or she is a member or within twelve months after he or she ceases to be a member, to contribute such sum (not exceeding £10.00) as may be demanded of him or her towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the Charity

incurred before he or she ceases to be a member, and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves.

8.1 The members of the Charity may at any time before, and in expectation of, its dissolution resolve that any net assets of the Charity after all its debts and liabilities have been paid, or provision has been made for them, shall on or before the dissolution of the charity be applied or transferred in any of the following ways:

a) directly for the Objects; or

b) by transfer to any charity or charities for purposes similar to the Objects; or

c) to any charity for use for particular purposes that fall within the Objects

8.2 Subject to any such resolution of the members of the Charity, the Trustees of the Charity may at any time before and in expectation of its dissolution resolve that any net assets of the Charity after all its debts and liabilities have been paid, or provision made for them, shall on dissolution of the charity be applied or transferred;

a) directly for the Objects; or

b) by transfer to any charity or charities for purposes similar to the Objects; or

c) to any charity for use for particular purposes that fall within the Objects

8.3 In no circumstances shall the net assets of the charity be paid or distributed among, the members of the Charity (except to a member that is itself a charity) and if no such resolution is passed by the members or the Trustees the net assets of the Charity shall be applied for charitable purposes as directed by the court or the Commission.
